
A Generous Donation Keeps our Cause Going


We are pleased to report that the leadership of the IgAN Foundation of America visited Columbia University on January 16th, 2016. The guests included the founder and the president of the foundation, Bonnie Schneider. The foundation has previously endorsed GIGA-kids, and expressed full commitment to promote and support the study. We met to discuss the best way to increase outside referrals and encourage patient participation. Notably, the IgAN Foundation of America has a long history of working with us on other projects, including the CureGN Study, as well as other genetic studies involving adult patients with IgA nephropathy.

The Foundation leaders were very impressed with our progress to date. As a reflection of their commitment to the study, they made a generous donation in the amount of \$10,000 towards GIGA-kids recruitment. These funds will be used to cover the costs of supplies for recruitment kits and shipment of blood samples.

We are very grateful for the support that they have provided for this study and we look forward to working and growing with them!








Figure 2: Recruitment per site – as of March 2016

The Usual News – Recruitment Numbers

We are now up to **159 enrollees into the GIGA kids Study**, including 155 pediatric cases and 4 controls. Based on *Figure 1* on page 1, you will see that March 16' has been our best month thus far. As predicted, the more sites that participate, the more that recruitment will increase. This is one of the many benefits of a multi-center study.

In *Figure 2* above shows the overall recruitment per institution/site. Currently, there are 15 active recruiting sites and each contributing to our overall goal. There are also 5 sites that are in the advanced stage of their IRB application process, which would soon put us up to nearly **20 sites actively recruiting!**

There have been several sites that have already been renewed by their IRB for another year of enrollment and most sites nearly exceeding their anticipated recruitment already. We thank all of you wholeheartedly for all of your hard work and commitment to this study.
